

How to connect your ZYGO sound bar.

The ZYGO sound bar is a basic sound bar that allows you to connect to an audio device in 3 ways.

The ZYGO soundbar uses 4 indicator lights to show what mode it is in:

Blue=Bluetooth White= RCA Green=Line IN Red=Standby

Using "Line IN"

The Line IN option commonly knows as AUX is a 3.5mm Headphone jack. You can use the cable provided to connect to a device with R&L RCA outputs as images below show or using the AUX cable provided to connect to a phone or tablet etc.





Using R&L RCA connections (Red/White inputs)

These options allow you to use the Cable provided to receive audio from a *headphone* output on a TV shown below or other device like phone tablet or PC, You can also use a RCA lead (not provided) to connect to devices like Freeview receivers or DVD players.





Using BlueTooth.

The device has a bluetooth mode (blue flashing light) this means its paring while the light is flashing you will be able to see the device show on your phone, tablet or PC.

What if you TV does not have the outputs required?

This can be the case if your TV is new or was manufactured with limited outputs, your TV may only have digital outputs like "optical" or "Coaxial" spdif.

In this case you will need to use an analog to digital converter.
